
JULY 19 ANNUAL PAINTED CANVAS EMBELLISHMENT with Julie Storick

Luxuriate in the beauty and elegance of this timeless waterlilies scene. This design was inspired while gazing down from a bridge, looking down onto the beautiful waterlilies from above. Reflections in the water of the sky and surrounding trees are rendered through gentle shading. Lily pads are created using mostly compound stitches on canvas. Learn stumpwork embroidery techniques to bring your flowers to life using mostly silks and overdyed threads.
