"HOPE" a painted canvas design by Kelly Clark and taught by Ritta Smith

Our very own Ritta Smith will teach this beautiful project for our annual painted canvas program. Designer Kelly Clark will donate 25% of the canvas proceeds to the Susan G. Koman Foundation to further research and fund a cure for breast cancer. Paid participants will receive the painted canvas, a stitch

guide created by Ritta and the threads* needed. A few of the stitches include a woven spider stitch for the flowers using silk ribbon; lazy daisy; French knots (lots of French knots!) and it has beads and sparkly pink threads. This piece will be finished all in pink too! Cynthia reminds us that paid, pre-registration was required and is now closed; however, if

you did not sign up for this wonderful program, Cynthia welcomes everyone to sit in on the class and pick up stitching ideas and tips. This should be a fun evening of stitching and learning and all for a good cause too! Supplies: Bring your usual stitching "tool kit" of supplies. Beading needles and thread not provided. The canvas design measures 4.5" round.
